Wire-free and easy to install, Dorgard devices use audio sensors to detect the building's fire alarm (any sound above a loud 65dB). To hold open the door, the user simply has to hold the door at the desired angle and push down the retaining foot. Upon 'hearing' a continual alarm, the Dorgard will release the retaining foot and allow the fire door to close under the pressure of the door's closer, thus helping to prevent the spread of fire throughout the building.
